

**RESOLUTION NO. 2003 -03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT THE CITY'S APPLICATIONS FOR EMPLOYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AND TAX EXEMPTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the City to submit an application to obtain a federal employer identification number and an application to the State of Florida to obtain and use a tax exemption (the Application"); and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate to authorize the Interim City Attorney to prepare and submit the Applications to the respective authorities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**



Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


