

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-32-70

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S BUDGET FOR 2004-2005 FISCAL YEAR; CREATING CERTAIN FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 4.5 of the City of Miami Gardens Charter, the City Council adopted a Budget for Fiscal Year 2004-2005, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City establish certain accounting funds for the FY 04-05 budget, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to amend the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 budget, based upon experience with revenues and expenditures, in order to accord with sound and accepted accounting principals, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to provide for certain transfers and appropriations based upon previous and anticipated expenditures and revenues,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to amend the budget to reflect these changes,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas Clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO BUDGET:

- A. The following amounts are hereby transferred for the operation and maintenance of the various Funds below, said monies currently appropriated as part of the

adopted annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2004, and ending September 30, 2005:

<i>FOR SPECIAL REVENUE FUND</i>	\$331,300
<i>FOR GENERAL SERVICES FUND</i>	\$2,317,566
TOTAL OPERATING TRANSFERS	<u>\$2,648,866</u>

- B. The following attachments are incorporated in this budget ordinance and is hereby approved as part of the Fiscal Year 2004 Budget: *Attachment #1 Projected Revenues and Expenditures, Special Revenue Fund; Attachment #2 Projected Revenues and Expenditures, General Services Fund; Attachment #3 budget detail.*

- D. The City Manager is authorized to move such funds as necessary from the adopted FY 04-05 budget in order to establish the Special Revenue Fund and the General Services Fund as shown in Attachments #1, #2 and #3. The City Manager is authorized to establish the appropriate interfund charge accounts necessary to establish a charge-back system. Any adjustment within a single fund may be approved by the City Manager, including apportioning budgets within funds to line items in the Chart of Accounts for the City.

- E. Any funds not utilized in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 budget in the Special Revenue Fund shall carry forward into the FY 05-06 budget without further appropriation for the purposes for which they were received. Interest accrued in this fund shall be moved to the General Fund at year-end.

SECTION 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY MANAGER: The City Manager shall take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. CONFLICT: All ordinances or Code provisions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and

independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
