A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A CHANGE ORDER TO THAT CERTAIN AWARD TO BEARINGPOINT, INC., FOR MANAGEMENT AND TECHNOLOGY CONSULTING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$66,273.75; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2007, the City Council awarded a bid to BearingPoint, Inc., in accordance with that certain State of Florida Bid No. 973-561-06-1, and

WHEREAS, the City requires additional consulting services for the Police Department from BearingPoint, Inc., in order to modify a video security system, configure an L-3 server and the network to support an in-vehicle camera system, as well as certain additional upgrades and deliverables, and

WHEREAS, BearingPoint, Inc., has provided a quote in the amount of \$66,273.75 for the additional work in accordance with the State of Florida Bid No. 973-561-0601, and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to authorize the City Manager to issue a change order to BearingPoint, Inc., in the amount of \$66,273.75,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:



Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a change order to that certain award of bid


to BearingPoint, Inc., in the amount of \$66,273.75 in accordance with that scope of work attached hereto as Composite Exhibit "A."

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Staff Summary

The City Council authorized the City Manager to issue a purchase order to BearingPoint Management & Technology Consultants on April 25, 2007 for the consulting firm to work with City staff and SunGard to ensure design, development and implementation of the complete OSSI network system in accordance with the State of Florida Contract for IT Consulting Services.

Analysis:

The OSSI network system is installed and is operational and was completed in time for the December 15, 2007 go-live date. Modifications to the PD communications center; modifications to the video security system, configuration of the L-3 server and the network to support the in-vehicle camera system; and trouble shooting are just some of the additional required services.

The Consulting services are also required for the upgrades and deliverables that are still pending and require installation and configuration. Some of these deliverables are: installation of Verisign Security for Outlook; installation of the backup domain controller and server;

installation of Mail Archiver software; adding E-notify to the firewall; and troubleshooting the web exchange. The quotations for additional services are attached as exhibit "A".

During this time we have made several attempts to fill vacancies in the IT department, including the Director, Police Administrator and Technician positions. While we found several candidates who were successful in the technical evaluations, they did not pass the extensive background checks required to access the Police network and NCIS databases.

These staffing vacancies have generated the need to rely on contracted services to provide the technical services required, especially in support of setting up and maintaining the Police Department. BearingPoint has performed these services at the rate stated in their initial agreement, plus approves expenses.

Recommendation:

That the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a change order to BearingPoint Management & Technology Consultants in the amount of \$66,273.75 in order to complete the additional installation, configuration and troubleshooting of the above mentioned deliverables and upgrades.
