A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MAROONE CHEVROLET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$52,164.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2008 CHEVROLET MALIBUS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2007, the City Council authorized the issuance of a bond in order to purchase additional vehicles and equipment for the City, and

WHEREAS, additional vehicles are necessary for City-wide purposes, and

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2007, the City advertised a bid for the purchase of various vehicles, and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2008, three (3) bids were received and publicly read, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the bids, it is being recommended that the City authorizes the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Maroone Chevrolet for three (3) 2008 Chevrolet Malibu vehicles,



Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Maroone Chevrolet in the amount of \$52,164.00 for the purchase of three (3) 2008 Chevrolet Malibus.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MAROONE CHEVROLET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$52,164.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2008 CHEVROLET MALIBUS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary

The City Council authorized financing in the amount of \$4.7 million for the purchase of additional vehicles and equipment on November 14, 2007, in order to enhance police and general citywide operations.

Analysis:

Additional vehicles are required in order to continue citywide operations. The Public Works department has additional staff to maintain the stormwater utility, Code Enforcement has additional officers to enforce the City's codes, KMGB has an additional Correctional Crew for continued litter maintenance throughout the City, the Building Department has additional inspectors to ensure timely inspections, the Parks and Recreational Department requires additional vehicles for recreational programs and parks maintenance. Administration vehicles are required in the Police, Code Enforcement and Planning and Zoning Departments.

Specifications were prepared by staff for the purchase and delivery of purchase and delivery of One (1) 2008 Ford F-350 Crew Cab, Two (2) 2008 Ford E-350 Club Wagon, One (1) 2008 Ford E-350 Club Wagon w/Towing package included, Six (6) 2008 Ford F-150 Pick-ups, One (1) 2008 Ford F-250 Super Cab, One (1) 2008 Ford F-250 Crew Cab, One (1) E-150 Standard Wagon, Two (2) Chevrolet Malibu and advertised on December 18, 2007. A broadcast notice was sent to 199 vendors. Twenty vendors requested bid packages. The bids were opened on January 10, 2008. Three bids were received and publicity read. A copy of the bid document and submittals are available at the assistant to the mayor and council's office for review. The tabulation sheet is attached as Exhibit "A".

The purchase of the E-350 Club Wagon and F-250 Crew Cab to be purchased from Gus Machado Ford, located in Hialeah, Florida does not exceed the City Manager's spending authority and therefore is not included in this agenda item for your approval.

Recommendation:

That the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Maroone Chevrolet, located in Pembroke Pines, Florida in the amount of \$52,164.00 for three 2008 Chevy Malibu.
