A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,000.00 FOR THE WIRING OF AN EMERGENCY STANDBY GENERATOR; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2007, the City Council authorized the purchase of an emergency standby generator from Florida Detroit Diesel, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the generator is to provide power supply to the City Hall in the event of an emergency, and

WHEREAS, grant funding from the Urban Area Security Initiative in the amount of \$190,000.00 is available from the federal government for this purchase, and

WHEREAS, the City's engineer prepared specifications for the purchase of a an emergency standby generator with trailer and specifications for the installation of the transfer switch at City Hall, and

WHEREAS, two bids were received and publicly read, and

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest and responsive bidder is Electrical Contracting Services, Inc., and City staff is recommending that the City Council award the bid to Electrical Contracting Services, Inc.,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a purchase order in the amount of \$54,000.00 to Electrical Contracting Services, Inc., for the wiring of the City's emergency standby generator with manual transfer switch.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,000.00 FOR THE WIRING OF AN EMERGENCY STANDBY GENERATOR; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary

The City Council authorized the purchase of an emergency stand-by generator to Florida Detroit Diesel on October 24, 2007. A stand-by emergency generator with trailer would provide power to City Hall any time an emergency occurs.

The Department of Homeland Security, through the Office of Grants and Training is providing financial assistance to several agencies in the Fort Lauderdale urban Area. Financial assistance will be provided to the City of Miami Gardens through the Fiscal Year 2006 Urban Area security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program for the purchase, delivery and installation of an emergency stand-by generator for a total of \$190,000.00.

Analysis:

The City Engineer prepared specifications for the purchase of a stand-by emergency generator with trailer and specifications for the installation of the transfer switch at City Hall. Once the generator was ordered with a delivery date, the bid for the electrical

wiring for the generator was advertised on January 11, 2008. A broadcast notice was issued to 652 suppliers. Twenty vendors requested bid packages. A mandatory pre-bid conference was held on January 22, 2008 with three vendors attending. Two bids were received and publicly read on February 7, 2008. A copy of the bid document and submittals are available at the assistant to the mayor and council's office for review.

The bids were evaluated for compliance with the specifications and the company's ability to wire the generator. Based on the evaluation, the apparent low and responsive bidder is Electrical Contracting Services, located in Hialeah, Florida. This company has a current contract with the City for the maintenance and repairs of all Parks lights. Copy of the tabulation is attached as Exhibit "A".

Recommendation:

We recommend that the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Electrical Contracting Service, Inc., located in Hialeah, Florida, in the amount of \$54,000.00 for the wiring of the emergency stand-by generator with a manual transfer switch.
