A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A SPONSORSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00), TO KINAD, INC., FROM THE WORKING CAPITAL RESERVE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, established in 2001, Kinad, Inc., is a non-profit human services community based organization, which hosts educational programs through its African American Mobile Museum, and

WHEREAS, Kinad, Inc., provides services for delinquency prevention, the enhancement of literacy skills and the improvement of physical fitness by integrating instruction on African American history, and

WHEREAS, Councilman Erhabor Ighodaro recommends that the City supports Kinad, Inc., with a sponsorship donation in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), to be allocated from the Working Capital Reserve,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes a sponsorship in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), to Kinad, Inc., from the Working Capital Reserve.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
