WHEREAS, in his recent State of the Union Address, President Barack Obama announced that he would be issuing an Executive Order to raise the minimum wage to Ten Dollars and Ten Cents (\$10.10) per hour for workers on new federal contracts, and

WHEREAS, as stated in the President's speech, raising the minimum wage will not only lower the unemployment rate, but will also provide economic security for American families, and

WHEREAS, Florida, represents a large number of unemployed citizens, and State Representative Cynthia A. Stafford and State Senator Dwight Bullard are sponsoring legislation in the State of Florida that will also raise the State's minimum wage to Ten Dollars and Ten Cents (\$10.10) per hour, to ensure economic security for Florida's families,

WHEREAS, Vice Mayor, Lisa Davis is requesting that the City Council also give its support to House Bill 385 and Senate Bill 456 which will raise the minimum wage to Ten Dollars and Ten Cents (\$10.10) per hour for Florida citizens,


