Article VII of the Miami Gardens Code entitled, “Lobbyist” requires that all lobbyists before engaging in any lobbying activities to register with the City Clerk and pay a one-time annual fee of \$250.00. This applies to all persons who are retained (whether paid or not) to represent a business entity or organization to influence “City” action. “City” action is broadly described to include the ranking and selection of professional consultants, and virtually all-legislative, quasi-judicial and administrative action. All not-for-profit organizations, local chamber and merchant groups, homeowner associations, or trade associations and unions must also register however an annual fee is not required.

Staff Summary:

The attached ordinance calls for the General Election for the City of Miami Gardens to take place on August 30, 2016, at which a Mayor will be elected for a four (4) year term; a Council member for Residential Area Seat 1 will be elected for a four (4) year term; a Council member for residential Area Seat 3, will be elected for a four (4) year term, and a Council member for at-large seat 5, will be elected for a four (4) year term. The Ordinance also provides for the closing of the election books (registered voters) thirty (29) days prior to the General Election. The qualifying dates for candidates will begin at 9:00 AM, Thursday, May 26, 2016, and end Thursday June 3, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. sharp!

A Run-Off Election, if necessary will take place Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

Fiscal Impact

A budget of \$35,000 is allocated in FY 2016 for election expenses.

Recommendation:

That the City Council approves the ordinance calling the City of Miami Gardens General Election for Tuesday, August 30, 2016.

14 WHEREAS, Section 5, Article V, of the City Of Miami Gardens' Charter provides
15 that a general election shall be held in each even-numbered year, on the day of the first
16 state primary election, or if none is held in any such year, on the first Tuesday, following
17 the second Monday in September, and

18 WHEREAS, a state primary Election will take place on August 30, 2016, and

19 WHEREAS, state law requires election books to close thirty (30) days prior to the
20 election,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
22 OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA:

23 SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas
24 Clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby
25 made a specific part of this Ordinance.

26 SECTION 2. ELECTION: The 2016 General Election for the City of Miami
27 Gardens will be held on Tuesday, August 30, 2016. On that date, a Mayor, and Council
28 members for Residential Area Seats One (1), Three (3), and Five (5) will be elected to
29 serve for four (4) year terms.

30 SECTION 3. RUNOFF ELECTION: The 2016 Runoff Election, if necessary for
31 the City of Miami Gardens will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

32 SECTION 4. QUALIFYING: The qualifying period for the election shall open
33 Thursday, May 26, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., and close precisely at 4:00 p.m., on Thursday,
34 June 3, 2016. Candidates shall qualify at the Office of the City Clerk, 18605 N.W. 27th
35 Avenue, Suite 317, Miami Gardens, Florida 33056.

36 SECTION 5. POLLING PLACES: Voting shall be conducted at locations
37 listed on Exhibit "A". All polls shall open precisely at 7:00 a.m., and close precisely at
38 7:00 p.m.

39 SECTION 6. OFFICIAL BALLOT: The official ballot for the 2016 Election is
40 in substantial form as the Ballot annexed to this ordinance as Exhibit "B".

41 SECTION 7. VOTER REGISTRATION: The election books shall close
42 Monday, August 1, 2016.

43 SECTION 8. NOTIFICATION: The City Clerk shall publish notice of such
44 general election once a week for four consecutive weeks next preceding the general
45 election in a newspaper of general circulation in Miami Gardens. The notice shall
46 contain the date, time, and place of the general election and identify the Council Seats
47 to be voted for.

48 SECTION 9. CONFLICT: All ordinances or Code provisions in conflict herewith
49 are hereby repealed.

50 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause,
51 phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any
52 court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and

53 independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining
54 portions of this Ordinance.

55 SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective
56 immediately upon its final passage.

In 2009, under Ordinance Number 2009-06-178 Council approved the borrowing of \$7.3 million for the acquisition of economic development property located at NW 7 avenue extension and NW 7 Ave (Warren Henry property). The bond Series 2009 which is held by Wells Fargo, NA is to be matured on February 1, 2014 with a balloon payment of \$6,311,999 in principal. The Council had approved three ordinances to extend the balloon payment until February 1, 2016.

At the May 14, 2014 Council meeting, Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate and enter in to a contract for the sale of the property. Numerous amendments to the contract for the sale have been executed and the closing date has been extended beyond February 1, 2016. In December, Finance has issued a Request for Proposal to seek responses for refinancing Series 2009. The City received only one response from Bank United. The Commitment Letter issued by the Bank United has the following terms and conditions:

- a) Interest costs – variable rate based on 30 days LIBOR rate plus 2.25%
- b) Revenue Pledge – Public Service Tax and State Revenue Sharing
- c) Commitment fee – 0.50% of the issue amount
- d) Bank Counsel fee - \$7,500
- e) Term: 3 year term, principal and interest payment semiannually in arrears with a balloon payment at maturity date.
- f) Pre-payment: the City of Miami Gardens can pre-pay the principal in whole or in part without penalty on or after October 1, 2016, subject to providing the Bank a 60-day notice prior to redemption of the bond.
- g) Deposit – the City must establish a depository relationship with the Bank with a minimum target balance of \$3 million.

Fiscal Impact

The City has retained Jeff Decarlo from Weiss Serota Helfman Cole and Bierman law firm to prepare the bond document and the ordinance. The cost is \$14,000. All legal expenses include bank counsel fees and the commitment fees will be part of the financing amount, so there is no immediate fiscal impact to the General Fund. However, in mid-year should the property is still under contract, staff will submit an Ordinance for Council approval to amend the budget to provide funding for the debt payment for fiscal year 2016.

Proposed Action:

That Council approves the ordinance on its first reading.

BankUnited, N.A. (the "Bank") is pleased to provide you with this Term Sheet outlining the basic terms and conditions currently being contemplated for the proposed extension of credit applicable to the refinancing of the City's Taxable Land Acquisition Revenue Bonds. This Term Sheet is subject to final credit approval pursuant to the following:

- Borrower:** City of Miami Gardens, Florida ("City or "Borrower").
- Amount:** Not to exceed \$6,400,000 in total (the "Series 2016 Loan Amount").
- Lender:** BankUnited, N.A. (the "Bank" or "Lender").
- Facility:** The obligation will be a variable rate term loan in an amount not to exceed the Series 2016 Loan Amount (the "Series 2016 Loan"). Interest on the obligation shall be taxable to the Lender.
- Closing Date:** On or about March 24, 2016 (the "Closing Date") or as otherwise mutually agreed upon by the Borrower and the Lender, but no later than March 31, 2016.
- Purpose/Use of Proceeds:** The Series 2016 Loan will fully refund the Taxable Land Acquisition Revenue Bonds Series 2009 and to pay for related costs of issuance, including Commitment Fees of the Bank and fees of counsel representing the Bank.
- Security:** The Series 2016 Loan shall be secured by a first lien on the revenues received from the tax on the purchase of electricity, which constitutes a portion of the **Public Service Tax** (also known as the utilities services tax) on parity with the QNIP debt payment under the interlocal agreement and Series 2009B, and a first lien on the revenues received from **State Revenue Sharing** pursuant to Section 218.23, Florida Statutes (the "Pledged Revenues").

Principal & Interest Payments:

The Series 2016 Loan will be subject to semi-annual principal and interest payments, commencing from and including the Closing Date to maturity or earlier prepayment.

Term/Maturity:

The Series 2016 Loan shall be for a term that extends to a final maturity of April 1, 2019, corresponding to an estimated annual debt service schedule set forth below:

Interest Rate:

The Series 2016 Loan shall bear interest for the period from and including the Closing Date to maturity or earlier prepayment at a variable rate equal to (i) LIBOR (as defined herein) plus (ii) 225 basis points (2.25 percent), subject to adjustment upon the occurrence of an Event of Default. The taxable interest rate on the Series 2016 Loan shall be a variable rate for the term of the facility extending to April 1, 2019 and shall be payable on each semi-annual interest payment date, commencing on October 1, 2016.

LIBOR:

LIBOR shall mean the London Interbank Offered Rate of Interest for an interest period of one (1) month, which rate appears on the day that is two London Business Days preceding the applicable Adjustment Date on the page of Bloomberg report service, or such similar service as determined by Lender, that displays the ICE Benchmark Administration (IBA) interest settlement rates of deposits in U.S. Dollars, as of 11:00a.m. (London, England time). "London Business day" shall mean any day on which commercial banks in London, England are open for general Business. "Business day" is defined as any day upon which the Lender is open for normal business other than a Saturday or Sunday or a day on which banks in the State of Florida are authorized or obligated by law, executive order or governmental decree to be


closed, and upon which the relevant international markets are open for business in London, England and Miami, Florida.

- Prepayment:** Subject to 60-day notice to the Bank, the Series 2016 Loan is subject to redemption prior to maturity at the option of the City, in whole or in part, on the first day of the month, following the 60-day notice, on or after October 1, 2016 at a redemption price equal to the principal amount of the Series 2016 Loan to be redeemed, plus accrued interest thereon to the date of redemption.
- Lender Counsel:** BankUnited will be represented by Greenberg Traurig (Robert Gang, esq.). Bank counsel fees (including expenses) are not expected to exceed \$7,500.
- Deposit & Accounts:** Borrower shall establish and maintain a depository relationship with the Bank with a minimum target balance of \$3,000,000. BankUnited is a Qualified Public Depository, as defined by the State of Florida and pursuant to Chapter 280, Florida Statutes.

- The City will not create or permit to be created any charge or lien on the Pledged Revenues or amounts in the funds and accounts created under the Resolution ranking equal with, prior to or subordinate to the lien on the Pledged Revenues without the prior written consent of the Bank.
- Additional Conditions:** The Series 2016 Loan shall not be rated by any rating agency, shall not be registered to participate in DTC, shall not contain a CUSIP number and shall not be marketed during any period in which the obligation is held by the Bank.
- Default Rate:** Under an a Event of Default, the Default Rate shall be calculated and immediately adjusted to a rate equal to the rate on the Series 2016 Loan plus three percent (3.00%).
- Default & Remedies:** The Bank shall be entitled to all remedies available under the financing documents and the Resolution. Upon the occurrence of an event of default under the Resolution, the financing documents will provide remedies to the Bank customary for transactions of this nature, exercise rights and remedies available under law, equity or under the terms of the Resolution and other financing documents.
- Annual Reporting Requirements:**
- (1) Prepare audited financial statements of the City. The audited financial statements will be mailed or delivered via electronic mail to the Bank on or before March 31 of each year for the fiscal year ending on the preceding September 30, commencing March 31, 2016 for the fiscal year ending on the preceding September 30, 2015.
 - (2) Prepare an annual budget of the City (the "Annual Budget"). The Annual Budget will be mailed or delivered via electronic mail to the Bank on or before October 15 of each year for the fiscal year beginning October 1, commencing October 15, 2016 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017.

Governing Law: All aspects of the Series 2016 Loan being discussed, including this Term Sheet, and any related financing documents would be governed by the laws of the State of Florida.





Staff Summary:

Background

The City leases roll off containers for the collection of waste at the City Hall, Parks and Recreation, Police Department and Public Works facilities. A service referred to as refuse collection services picks up these containers at different interludes depending on the needs of the Department. These containers are used by our maintenance crews to dispose of litter and trash collected from the City Hall Facilities, Police Department, Right of Ways and Parks. The current contract for this service has expired.

Current Situation

On December 21, 2015, Staff prepared specifications for Invitation To Bid (ITB) Number 15-16-022, Refuse Collection of Leased Containers, which was solicited and posted on Demandstar. A broadcast notice was sent to one hundred eighty-one (181) suppliers. Four (4) bids were received and publicly read on January 12, 2016. The apparent low respondent is Waste Management of Florida, Inc., located in Miami, Florida. The Procurement Department evaluated the bids for compliance with the specifications (Exhibit 1).

The initial period of the proposed contract is for two (2) years, from date of award through February 2018, for a total maximum not to exceed amount of one hundred thirty thousand (\$130,000) dollars for a two-year period.

A copy of the proposal document and submittals are available at the Assistant to the Mayor and Council's Office for review.

Fiscal Impact

In Fiscal Year 2016, the City has provided a funding from the General Fund and Stormwater Fund in the amount of \$78,320 for refuse and trash collection service. The amount is within the proposed award amount for a one year period.

Proposed Action:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the award to Waste Management of Florida, Inc., and authorizing the City Manager to issue purchase orders for each Department: City Hall Facilities, Police Department, Parks and Recreation Department and the Public Works Department, not to exceed the annual budget allocation.

Staff Summary:

BACKGROUND

In April 2014, the City of Miami Gardens' residents approved a General Obligation Bond in the amount of \$60,000,000 for the construction of and improvements to the City's parks and related facilities. The City

Council subsequently approved a Bond Implementation Plan that lists and details the proposed improvements at each park facility or municipal property.

On July 15, 2015, staff issued Request For Qualifications (RFQ) Number 14-15-034 for Norwood Park and Pool Improvements, Step One, inviting Design-Build firms or teams to provide qualifications for future design-build contract for a new recreational building, renovation of the existing pool house, new playground and shade structure and related facility improvements, technical, schedule and cost proposals to implement an overall improvement project at Norwood Park and Pool, located at 19401 NW 14th Avenue. A broadcast notice was sent to seven hundred seventy-one (771) vendors. Forty-one (41) proposals were requested. The RFQ opened on August 20, 2015 and seven (7) proposals were received and publicly read. The RFQ was prepared in accordance with Florida Statue 287.055 Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA).

On September 1, 2015, the Selection Committee short-listed four (4) firms: D. Stephenson Construction Inc.; Di Pompeo Construction Corporation; Recreational Design & Construction, Inc.; and West Construction, Inc.

CURRENT SITUATION

The Procurement Department applied the City of Miami Gardens Business and Resident Economic Growth Plan (CMG-BREP) preference to this project. D. Stephenson Construction, Inc.; Di Pompeo Construction Corporation; Recreational Design & Construction, Inc.; and West Construction, Inc., were compliant to the City of Miami Gardens Business Resident Economic Growth Plan (Exhibit 2).

On December 17, 2015, Request For Proposal (RFP) Number 15-16-023, Step Two, was issued to the four (4) short-listed vendors. The RFP opened on February 2, 2016. Proposals from D. Stephenson Construction, Inc.; Recreational Design & Construction, Inc.; and West Construction, Inc., were received and publicly read.

City Staff reviewed the proposals and determined that D. Stephenson Construction, Inc., and Recreational Design & Construction, Inc. were both non-responsive to the established Maximum Bid Price requirement listed in the RFP. After evaluation of the proposal, City Staff determined that West Construction, Inc. was both responsive and responsible to the requirements of the RFP. City Staff recommended West Construction, Inc. for award (Exhibit 1).

A copy of the proposal document and submittals are available at the Assistant to the Mayor and Council's Office for review.

Proposed Action:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the recommendation for award for RFP Number 15-16-023, Norwood Park and Pool Improvements, Step Two, to West Construction, Inc. and authorize the City Manager to proceed with negotiations.





The Miami Gardens Police Department provides information concerning crimes in the City of Miami Gardens. Each page depicts actual crime information captured by the Records and Crime Analysis Units.

Glossary

Targeted Crimes:

The State of Florida uses these crimes for conformity in compiling statistics within the state and the nation. The statistics for these crimes are reported to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement for inclusion in the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) Annual Report. Data from the monthly report may differ from the FBI's published report due to the fact that only certain classes of crime are extracted for publication and crimes reported after the reporting deadline are still captured by the Records Unit.

- **Criminal Homicide** – The willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.
- **Aggravated Assault** – An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury.
- **Larceny** – Deprive victim of such property permanently or temporarily without threat or violence or putting in fear, or by sudden snatch.
- **Robbery** – To take or attempt to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting victim in fear.
- **Burglary** – The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft.

GLOSSARY

Emergency Calls

P = Priority call and is identified by a verbal '3' at the beginning of the signal at dispatch

Code 3 emergency call: A situation or sudden occurrence which poses an actual threat of serious injury or loss of human life and demands swift police action. Code 3 calls are preceded by a tone indicator and the signal prefixed by a 3.

Example: Shooting victim, violent domestic with injuries, accident with injuries

P1 = Emergency call that is identified by a verbal '2' at the beginning of the signal at dispatch.

Code 2 emergency call: A situation which poses a potential threat of serious injury or loss of human life which may require swift police action. Code 2 calls are preceded by a tone indicator and the signal prefixed by a 2.

Example: Burglary in progress, violent domestic, assault with potential of injuries.

P2 = requires an immediate response but no imminent threat of serious injury or loss of human life involved. There is no tone indicator preceding this type of call.

Example: A just occurred burglary or any incident where the suspects may still be in immediate area.

P3+ = Considered a routine response for a call that is delayed or non-emergency in nature.

Example: Identity theft, loud music complaints, barking dog disturbance.












ROUTINE CALLS FOR SERVICE 2015 / 2016
